

CFS MYPoW 2024-2027 MID-TERM REVIEW – WORKPLAN (2025)

OVERALL OBJECTIVE

Implement a structured, inclusive and efficient process for the preparation of the CFS 2024-2027 MYPoW Mid-Term Review, which will complement the annual update of the rolling section, by assessing and adjusting, if necessary, the remaining elements of the MYPoW until 2027.

EXPECTED OUTCOMES

An adjusted programme of work for 2026-2027 is prepared for consideration and endorsement by the CFS Plenary in 2025, taking into account the evolving global context, availability of resources and overall workload.

GUIDING QUESTIONS

The following guiding questions are proposed as potential areas of focus for the Mid-Term Review:

- 1) Which elements, if any, of the 2026-2027 programme of work would benefit from further discussion with a view to sharpen their objectives and expected outcomes?
- 2) Which element, if any, of the 2026-2027 programme of work would benefit from further discussion with a view to align with the evolving global context and initiatives relevant to food security and nutrition?
